Our profession has encountered many challenges as we navigate through tumultuous unknown of practicing within the COVID 19 pandemic. Safety for our patients, our staff, families and self are our priorities as we adjust to a new "norm" of dental practice. There are updated guidelines from the American Dental Association and the Center for Disease Control located on their perspective websites.

AAWD has been proactive legislatively as our organization signed to support the Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) Flexibility Act: HR 7010. PPP Flexibility Act was passed unanimously on May 28 and allows small businesses more time and flexibility to utilize the PPP funds.
