

The Importance of Viable Professional Development Programs For Women Junior Faculty

Known for its mission of service to the underserved, Meharry Medical College School of Dentistry has served as a beacon in the city of Nashville for nearly 150 years. From community events including "Oral Health Day", which provides free oral health care for hundreds of uninsured and underserved individuals in the Nashville community, to the "Adopt-A-Grandparent Program" that pairs a clinical dental student with a senior member of the community in need of dentures, the Meharry Medical College School of Dentistry has a plethora of programs that seek to uphold the mission of the College: Service to the Underserved.

As a 2010 graduate of Meharry School of Dentistry (SOD), and current a faculty member in the Department of Dental Public Health and active member of the AAWD, I've found myself (as many of you) constantly seeking for a means to provide service to the underserved beyond the clinic walls. One such pathway has been the Deans Scholar Program which has been in existence since 2007, SOD. Through encouragement from my former Chair, Dr. Jacinta Leavell, as well as being selected for the program by the SOD Dean, Dr. Cherae Farmer-Dixon, I became immersed in educational leadership programs including the Academy of Academic Leadership (AAL) and the Teachers Professional Leadership Opportunity that provide educational strategies that allow for participant engagement while attending courses both in-person and virtually.

However, the component of the Deans Scholar Professional Development Program that has allowed me to be of greatest service to faculty, students, and the community has been admittance and participation in the University of Rochester/Jacobi Medical Center Dental Public Health Residency Program. As both a junior faculty and a resident, I am afforded the opportunity to further my education in the field of dental public health, build upon knowledge learned and educate the next generation of oral health care professionals. A viable component of this residency program is the opportunity to complete research projects that focus on service to the underserved both clinically and virtually using teledentistry.

Women junior faculty in dental academia play a vital role in educating faculty, staff, students, and patients through the use of viable institutional professional development programs. We must educate ourselves and pass the baton to the next generation of dentists to make a powerful impact within our communities. Hats off to all the incredible women junior faculty in dental academia who are making a difference globally!


for a webinar hosted by the Meharry Student AAWD Chapter
