PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

For many people, May ushers in spring blooms and warming weather. For 5% of Americans, May may offer a reprieve from Seasonal Affective Disorder (SAD). Mental Health America reports that four out of five people who suffer from SAD are women. Mhanational.org reports that 22% of Americans suffer from depression. May is designated Mental Health Awareness month, in which people are encouraged to support mental health in various ways. The National Alliance on Mental Illness is hosting a 2022 campaign: Together for Mental Health (#Together4MH). The campaign invites healthcare providers to engage with people to raise awareness about Mental Health. For example, by hosting a book club that includes titles and conversation relevant to mental illness. "Turtles All the Way Down" by Jon Green; "On Edge: A Journey Through Anxiety" by Andrea Petersen; "Crazy Is My Superpower" by AJ Mendez Brooks; "Eleanor Oliphant Is Completely Fine: A Novel" by Gail Honeyman; "The Lonely Century" by Noreena Hertz are a few examples.

After two years of isolation during the COVID-19 pandemic, mental wellness has moved to the forefront as an integral part of overall health. In 2020, Congress passed legislation making 9-8-8 the nationwide mental health hotline number. As dental healthcare providers, this is an important component of patient wellness that may need an update in some of our health history exams. For more patient resources, the National Alliance on Mental Illness and Mental Health America are two research-based organizations aiming to bring awareness to Mental Health in America.

May 8, Mother's Day, also begins National Women's Health Week. The CDC suggests making mental health a priority, in addition to physical health. The office on women's health (womenshealth.gov) offers suggestions on how to participate in #NWHW that include self-care practices that aim to improve mental wellness. Another important resource to continue to share is SAMHSA's National Helpline – 1-800-662-HELP (4357) a free, confidential, 24/7, 365-day-a-year treatment referral and information service (in English and Spanish) for individuals and families facing mental and/or substance use disorders.

Please make these resources available to your friends, family and patients. Seek the support you need to support others around you. As women, we often overlook our own needs to care for others. I hope this May you're reminded that you are a priority. As always, my email is open to any and all conversation.

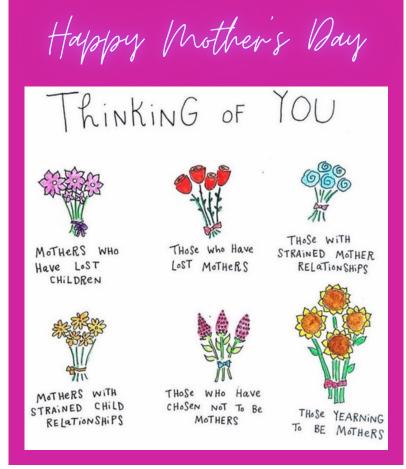
AS QUOTED IN TUFTS NOW:

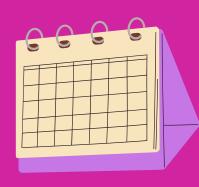
