



Dr. Glenn is a Clinical Associate Professor in the Department of Orthodontics at Texas A&M School of Dentistry. She received her dental degree from the University of Texas Dental School in San Antonio, then went on to receive her master's degree and specialty certificate in orthodontics from Baylor College of Dentistry. Dr. Glenn practiced orthodontics in Dallas, TX for 37 years and is Board Certified by the American Board of Orthodontics. She served as the first female president of the American Association of Orthodontists in 2013-2014. Dr. Glenn has been the recipient of numerous professional awards including the 2020 Lucy Hobbs Taylor Award from AAWD.
