The Smiles for Success Foundation (SFS) offers cost-free dental care to women who have graduated from accredited job readiness and placement programs or other community-based agencies. The care offered is meant to be a short-term solution for those who need treatment that is not available to them. SFS's goal is to help women confidently obtain employment and financial independence by rejuvenating smiles, boosting self-esteem, and enhancing self-respect.





Smiles for Success works with a network of community programs, volunteer dentists (our own AAWD members!), volunteer labs, and community sponsors to provide services for women in transition from welfare to work. <u>Donations</u> are always appreciated to help our volunteer dentists and labs provide the best care for these women and educate the women on continued proper dental care.

Dr. Isabella Christianson galina




